## **DEATH**

One day my brother called me to tell me that my grandmother, who had lived in a social services home for a long time, was in hospital and was not very well. He also asked me if I wanted to visit her and since the hospital was in another city, I immediately accepted to go. He was just arriving home from work, so he came for me by his car. Our mother could not go with us to see her sick mother because she was also unwell, suffering from a strong viraemia and fever. As I left home, I focused only on one thing - not to say farewell but to encourage a close person, for whom an important moment was waiting.

When we arrived at the hospital, we found her ward and room very easily. As I reached for the door handle, my brother suddenly stopped me so that he could gain some courage saying: "wait, I don't know whether I am ready for it....." I didn't understand his hesitation and the need to gain courage, but then I realized that our purpose for the visit was different: I had the knowledge of basic eternal - God's Laws, which I've experienced and they're my absolute support, while he had not experienced it yet. But I needed to support him and I said: "we're going to encourage our grandmother", and of course he entered the room. He's a good and strong man, but at that moment a fear plagued him, the fear from the unknown, the fear from DEATH.

Our grandmother was alone in the hospital room because additionally some very contagious streptococcus, against which her organism couldn't fight, infected her. Because of this we had to put on masks and hand gloves. She lay in a bed, very skinny and in great pain. The pain was so much that she couldn't look at anyone or even say a single word or cough. She barely moaned.

We greeted our aunt whom we found there with her. At that moment I went straight to our grandmother, I grabbed her hand, greeted her, gave regards from my mother and then I told her everything that I had to say without caring what my brother and aunt would think about it. I don't remember exactly what I said, but I know that it was from my deepest inside. I said that we all love her and we thank her for everything. And that another path awaits her now, but she doesn't have to worry because it will be fine; that she is a good person and she will take it with her there and it will help her. I do not remember if I said anything else, but I know that I said what I felt at that moment. Then I held her hand and tried to give her calmness, power and support through myself. I felt a vibrant heat that was flowing. I tried to encourage my aunt as well. She looked at me so surprised as if she didn't understand how I can be so calm and I don't cry. It seemed to me that she thought I'm not sensitive, but it wasn't true. How could I be cold when someone is suffering? I just knew that this suffering has a meaning and it's not unfair, and it can serve our grandmother. This knowing and wanting to help gave me strength to be calm. I sensed that grandma needed calmness and support at that moment. This would also help her to complete her survival in pain in this earthly life, which gave her a chance to atone something and move further spiritually. I asked them to turn off the light in the middle of the room and turn on a little one next to the door. My aunt was reluctant but they did it, and it seemed it was better for our grandmother.

I told her more about death and to me it appeared that her spirit felt something about it because at that time, it was situated somewhere between a gross material world and an ethereal world.

When we were going home from the hospital my brother said something that surprised me. He told me that he even doesn't know whether he's glad that we went to see our grandmother. I didn't understand so he told us about the funeral of his father in law. My brother's wife didn't want to see the body of her father at his funeral because apparently, she wanted to remember him alive. And my brother felt the same at that moment.

I told him I was glad that we went there, because actually I don't take it like that. The important thing for me is to support a person who is leaving; our grandmother or brother's father in law as well.

On the following day, my brother phoned me and I knew what he was going to tell me; our grandmother had died. Suddenly my brother said that he is actually glad that we went to see her in hospital.

The funeral took place within two days at my grandmother's home. We went there by car together with my mother, still a little bit ill, my brother and I. We actually symbolized **three basic groups of people**, with three different attitudes to death; close family members joined by an inherent uniformity, but each of us walking in separate direction according to own free will.

Our mother, who is an atheist, represents the first group. She understands death as something finite, as the end of existence. My brother - a believer and a member of the church, represents the second group. He believes that man has a soul and not just a physical body. But he lacks the necessary knowledge of the eternal – natural laws and his unrealistic interpretation that a man lives on earth only once, and then his soul goes to heaven or hell forever, along with other illogical explanations that can't give him the necessary support. And it shows especially in such situations, when he faces a great "unknown" issue, when he doesn't know why, who or when one must die, and why some people have to suffer so much and others don't. He's scared and he thinks that these questions don't have answers and therefore he doesn't have to look for them! While the opposite is true! Above all he lacks knowledge of reincarnation- repeated return of human spirit to Earth, which explains and demonstrates FAIRNESS in our entire existence. Everybody reaps what he's sowed through his deeds, thoughts, and feelings, either in this or the next life. A man has parents, exactly what he deserves, he also experiences happiness or unhappiness, what he's weaved for him. Coincidences do not exist. (Actions of dark forces interfere in this as well, but final settlement is always based on what an individual deserves). And I represent the third group. I don't belong to any community, I'm just an independent reader of the Word of Truth -The Grail Message and I've understood the basic information and the context of this work of Truth, and therefore I already look at life in terms of eternal - God's laws.

We arrived at the cemetery and entered into the house of mourning, where grandmother's body lay in a coffin. We exchanged greetings with my aunt, uncle and their families. When I walked into that room, I felt exactly the same as at the funeral of my grandfather, and of brother's father in law. I felt that her soul is still close to her body, that I can still talk to her. Perhaps I smiled for a moment just as you see a close person and then I caught surprised looks of bystanders, who couldn't explain my feelings. Maybe I seemed to be insensitive for them once again but I didn't care about it.

Grandmother's face looked as if she smiled. She was so pretty and femininely gentle, her body proved how much relief her death had brought to her. I felt quite clearly that her soul perceived me, so I greeted her and told her I am glad that she is better now. I knew that I don't even talk to her out loud I can easily communicate with her through thoughts. I couldn't hear the concrete words or see her soul by a finer sight, as some people could do, I just felt clearly her reactions. I was saying something like she died, but she can see her soul lives on. That she had just taken off her material body and development of her spirit continues. I told her that just as she lived this life, she had lived a number of previous lives on Earth before, during which she was collecting all experiences. And a fact that we can return back to Earth repeatedly is a huge gift for us because we can develop ourselves here; because our true essence—is a spirit that comes down to gross matter world as a tiny seed from a spiritual realm. The spirit should become stronger gradually through many lives to be allowed to come back to the realm - from where he comes as a small seed - to the higher world, back to the

spiritual realm, where he will be allowed to live in a fully consciousness of joy and happiness - forever. I told her that all these worlds - the spiritual realm, all worlds below it up to our gross matter world where we are now, and also all the huge worlds even higher above us such as Paradise of human spirits, with superior and much more beautiful creatures than humans, are made and created by our only Lord, gracious God. And He put the laws into the creation, according to which all worlds and realms work and can progress. But we humans on Earth haven't recognized these laws, although they were brought to us many times, we always rejected them. And so we still break them, we disrupt the balance because of our ignorance of these laws and therefore we experience different suffering during our life.

The first law is the **Law of homogeneity** by which only same kinds can merge and combine. An alien species can't be mixed. The second law is the **Law of gravity**; everything that is light, bright, clean is located higher and everything that is heavy, dirty, is below. The third one is the **Law of reciprocal action** or the so-called karma, according to which everything that we do, think and feel always returns back to us.

I told her how important time is nowadays; about the fact that the time reserved for a development of human spirits in a gross material world is going to end. That we, humans, in our arrogance have still refused advice and help from the Light, which constantly tried to bring us an explanation of Eternal Laws in Creation through its envoys; to understand them, live according to them, to develop ourselves and uplift our surroundings, not to do harm to ourselves and everything around us. And also the Law of reciprocal action will conclude this in a circle. All evil that we humans have committed will result in a climax of promised Judgement, predicted even in the Bible. The situation on Earth will be worse and every human spirit will have to demonstrate what he really is.

I explained to her that great suffering awaits us, but those who will manage to develop themselves and will persevere in their efforts, will be saved by Imanuel with His crowds of faithful entities from higher worlds. That Imanuel is also the Son of God like Jesus. Jesus is God's Love and Imanuel is God's Will and Justice. And all creation, in which we live, was created through Imanuel! Imanuel is promised Son of Man, who will come in time of Judgement!

I directed her to **The Grail Message** and **The Eternal Laws** and assured her that these works are certainly found in finer world as well, where she is going now. And in these works she can find **an uncorrupted Truth**, necessary knowledge of eternal laws, a structure of all creation and knowledge of the Lord. Thus spiritual **bread** is contained in these works!

Then I tried to tell her that we all will leave after the funeral and she should try to break away from her body and to go towards her further development. At that moment I felt she already knew it and she was happy that she was already in the next world, I don't know if it was because of a relief from the pain, or of potential meetings with close souls who came to welcome her in this world.

For sure I let her know that if she'll have problems to break away from the gross matter world and her soul will still be here, she can come to me at any time and I will tell her what she will need to know. I also told her that next few days I will listen to the first part of Eternal Laws — audio recordings, step-by-step, chapter-by-chapter, so she can come to listen to it with me if she wants. But anyway she shouldn't spend more time here in the gross matter world than it's necessary.

But probably I forgot about one thing — to warn her about darkness. I feel really sorry about it. Well, but I told her quite enough and the rest she can find in those works, if she wants. In this communication with her there was no effort to tutor or force anything. There was only spontaneity and I acted just on the basis of my feelings. Although I was thinking in advance what I would like to say to her, finally I did it in the way it came out of me naturally. When I was describing the perfection of the eternal laws and goodness of our Lord, I was so

overwhelmed by this beauty and glory that tears came out from my eyes and grandmother felt it very intensively.

Now I'll say something about the ceremony itself and people there. Shortly after we entered the house of mourning, and I verified the presence of the soul of grandmother, I got closer to my mother who suffered and felt very sorry that she couldn't come to see her mother two days ago because of her sickness; or maybe she was sorry for other things, or something that remained unspoken between her and her mother. That's why I encouraged her: "Mom, I know you're an atheist and don't believe in those things, but I can tell you with absolute certainty that I clearly feel that grandmother's soul is still here close to her body and she can still perceive. So if you want to tell her something, you can do it, she will hear you."

She heard me, but then she - even physically as well - hesitated and said: "No, I don't believe in it." In her reaction there was so much pain and intransigence, so I started to feel sad about it. Despite her reaction, I think my certainty and the sentences touched her and nevertheless her spirit was moved by pain and I believe that she told her mother everything what she wanted. Just she still doesn't understand that mother's soul heard it. Therefore, I think my mom still suffers for something that is unnecessary, but she still tows burdens of the past with her, instead of joyful progress.

My brother was brave too, but I saw that he suffered as well and was in great strain when confronted with death and had problems with unanswered questions and uncertainty.

The ceremony was public. A lady who gave a speech appeared to me as a sensitive person who was trying to encourage us. But encouragement remained at the level of gross matter because of not knowing about the spirit of man. She was talking about how our grandmother left an impression in all of us. It's true as well that she ended her path in this life, it's true that it was time to say goodbye to her, as well as the fact that we all have reserved time here. But!... a basic fact was lacking — that she still exists! That she as a human spirit is located only in a finer matter world than ours, and her path still continues as well as our own; now at the time of the Judgement, when we have little time to change ourselves!

I saw a cousin who cried so much and I felt sad that other people don't see it as I do. They don't know that grandmother still exists and she still needs our support, that "love conquers all" and we can still help her with our pure feelings and wishes, even if she's elsewhere.

I don't want to downplay the pain of those who were with her every day and will miss her, and whose life will change, but I just want to say that **if they KNEW THE TRUTH**, they would take it differently, they would be stronger and their sadness and pain from losing a close person would not be in the forefront, despite the inevitable farewell with a loved person. If **a yearning to LIVE according to God's will**, thus **in accordance with the eternal laws** was in the first place for them, they would accept the time of farewell with humility. And also they would support her soul and wish her good luck on her next path instead of the grief. Thus there would be no passive helplessness and gloom but active volition for the good. And this would move the sadness to the second place, or more precisely, it would direct their train to the right station.

And once when people on Earth enter in the promised Millennial Empire, they will be spiritually advanced than they're now and this sadness won't be so great or perhaps there will be no sadness like this! Because if they will live according to God's Laws, they'll believe that they'll move higher after their death, thus the death of a loved person means a progress for him! And who wouldn't enjoy the welfare and happiness of loved person? Moreover, spiritually advanced individuals can occasionally communicate out of our space and time, so in the future the farewell will not be the same, as we understand it today from a level of our development.

I know what sadness of the death of a loved person is; I've experienced it as well, and the death scared me and it was synonymous with endless pain and loss, until I discovered the

Truth. So today when I try to live my life correctly here in this body, I'm not scared of death anymore just because of the knowledge and subsequent experience! And I don't worry about a separation from loved people, because I know that eventually everything will be according to the Will of the Lord, thus according to the Eternal Laws, as I myself deserve. My ultimate goal and effort is to live in accordance with these laws; and I have the experience that when I do it, it fills me with indescribable happiness!

People are afraid of the unknown - and therefore many people are afraid of death. It frightens them because they don't know it, don't want to think about it, and the topic of death irritates them. Or they're afraid of the responsibility that death is not the end, and they will reap what they have sown and therefore they want to escape. They also feel that they miss something important — a spiritual development — and only go about earthly distractions and activities, that they'll soon regret. A man has not only the right but also the duty to find out who he is, where he comes from and where he's going. And this is perfectly explained in **The Grail Message** and **The Eternal Laws**.

Therefore, death is a natural part of life here in gross matter world, and even if we close our eyes towards it, nobody can escape from it because substance is subjected to constant formation, development and subsequent decay. But there's one thing which is not subject to decay – it's the spirit of man – if he evolves himself quite enough to the intended time. If, however, he still remains dormant, a spiritual death awaits him, which means a real disappearance of his personality, and that is the worst thing that can happen to him!

A man has a desire within himself to live forever, and he can achieve the eternal life – in a spiritual realm, in paradise!

But first he would have to DO something for it!!!
